THE CENTER ACCEPTS THE FOLLOWING ITEMS CO-MINGLED TO BE EMPTIED INTO SPECIFIED BIN NO ITEMS ACCEPTED IN PLASTIC BAGS EXCEPT FOR SHREDDED PAPER:

ALL COLORS OF GLASS, TIN CANS AND

ALL CARDBOARD & MIXED PAPER PRODUCTS SHOULD BE FLATTENED BOXED or BAGGEDTO BE DEPOSITED IN DESIGNATED BIN.


SCRAP IRON & ALUMINUM CANS- May be brought to the center & deposited in the areas designated.

APPLIANCES & ELECTRONICS - May be brought to the center & deposited in the area designated. (Washers, Dryers, Water Heaters, Stoves are accepted.) Refrigerators, Freezers, Humidifiers, Dehumidifiers, TV=s, Computers, Microwaves etc. will be accepted for a fee collected by the attendant.

LEAD ACID BATTERIES - May be brought to the recycling center & deposited in the area designated.

WASTE OIL - IS NOT ACCEPTED AT THE CENTER FOR DISPOSAL

NO OLD TIRES, WINDOWS, OR PLASTIC BAGS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

THE COMPOST CENTER IS OPEN TO THE RESIDENTS OF VALDERS AT ALL TIMES.

COMPOST ITEMS - Grass clippings, yard and garden waste may be deposited at the compost site and placed on the appropriate pile. ALL LEAVES & CLIPPINGS MUST BE REMOVED FROM PLASTIC BAGS.

BRUSH & TREE LIMBS - May be deposited on the brush pile for future chipping and composting.

NO SCRAP LUMBER OR STUMPS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Village residents may utilize the composted ground or chipped brush for landscaping purposes.

MIXED PAPER includes many types of waste paper products generated in the home. Paper products MUST be dry and free of food residues and restroom waste.

PAPER can be mixed together and placed in bags or small boxes which can also be recycled. Flatten boxes to save space. Place separated paper on top of, or next to, your full recycling bin.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD MUST be flattened and boxed, bagged,


NEWSPAPERS MUST be boxed, bagged;

PREPARING GLASS AND CANS FOR RECYCLING




RINSE your cans and glass.




CRUSH cans if possible to save space.


PREPARING PLASTIC FOR RECYCLING




IDENTIFY: Only containers with these codes (on the bottom of the container) are acceptable; the base must be larger than opening.



RINSE your containers. You don't have to remove any labels.




REMOVE caps, rings and pumps and place them with regular garbage.



FLATTEN, if possible, so it takes up less space.

PREPARING PAPER FOR RECYCLING



RECYCLING IS MANDATORY -- THERE IS A PENALTY FOR NON-COMPLIANCE
